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CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PLAYERS

Montrose Youth Football Club requires the following commitment from players on successful completion and acceptance of their Scottish Youth Football Association (SYFA) signing on form.

- Behaviour and personal conduct must at all times be of a high standard and designed to reflect favourably on the Club. Any other behaviour is unacceptable.
- Language in public or relevant group situations must always be appropriate and socially acceptable.
- Players must not post offensive remarks about any other Montrose Youth Football Club Manager, Coach or Player on social networking sites such as (but not restricted to) Facebook, Bebo and Twitter.
- Alcohol and tobacco products are forbidden for use by players under age as defined by law. These products must not be purchased, used or consumed by **any** team member whilst en route, prior to, during or following a Club activity, without specific consent of the team manager.
- Information on all medication being taken by a player should be reported to the team manager.
- Sexual intimacy is forbidden during situations where the player is under the jurisdiction of the Club.
- To give adequate notification to the team manager of any factors which may necessitate declining to participate in any arranged Club activities.
- Willingness to participate whenever possible in any promotional or fund raising projects on behalf of the Club.
- Personal appearance will be appropriate to the circumstances and as indicated by the team manager.
- Team kit and equipment as issued shall be worn as directed by the team manager when assembling, travelling and competing at official team functions, or other occasions as notified.
- Players must attend all meetings and other functions as directed by the team manager.
- Punctuality on all occasions is essential.
- Shin Guards should be worn at all times during training and matches.

SANCTIONS

Breaches of the above Code of Conduct shall be dealt with in the first instance by the appointed team manager. At the manager's discretion, any incident may also be reported to the General Committee who may take such further action as is deemed necessary. This may ultimately result in the player being asked to leave the Club.
